I also request that you submit an .eps, .ps or .tif file containing the "Graphic Abstract" figure, or an artistic rendering that you consider best exemplifies your work, make sure to label it "Graphic Abstract" and include the caption.

Please submit all files within 3 days, as to not delay the publication process. Once you have completed the submission of your final files, you will not be able to make changes until you have received your page proofs from IEEE.

Please note that adding or removing Author names is not allowed at this time. If modifications of the Authors list are needed, the revised file must be uploaded as a new submission. An explanation of the changes must be included in the letter to the Editor.

Within approximately one week, your paper will be assigned a Digital Object Identifier (DOI) and will be placed on the "Forthcoming articles" section on IEEE Xplore. In parallel, your manuscript will be revised by the Copy Editor, who will generate the proofs. You will receive an email with instructions on accessing your page proofs at a secure website.

It is important that you correct, or approve, the proofs immediately. Failure to do so after 3 days will result in your paper being published as is. Once published, you cannot make any additional changes. In its final copy-edited version, the paper will be permanently archived in the Journal's homepage with the appropriate volume, issue, and page number information.
